





Part 2B Certification of Team Funding and Support**

- No patented invention has been developed under government funding in part of my team's vehicle unless the patented invention is commercially available or is openly available to all Grand Challenge teams on June 8, 2004, and through the duration of the Grand Challenge.
- Government-owned equipment has not been used and will not be used in the design, development, or operation of my team's Grand Challenge vehicle.


For purposes of this certification, government funding denotes any form of support from a national or international government's organization, whether located in the United States of America or in any foreign country or territory. Openly available materials are available without charge, such as software that is available for public download.

I understand that failure to provide certification will result in automatic disqualification from the DARPA Grand Challenge and may result in other penalties such as suspension of USG, OSAC, IR&D, or making a false statement.

Purpose:


