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Integrator/Broker Overview

Key: Integrator/Broker (or team) must perform “minimum” tasks, but may need to perform additional tasks.

845 OTA w/ milestones, award fee.

Min. value: \$4M/yr.

PoP: through Sep 2009.

6 objectives of the Integrator/Broker

- Act as an honest broker within the consortium.
- Facilitate, coordinate, and (if necessary) complete the development of the J-UCAS enterprise architecture.
- Facilitate, coordinate, and (if necessary) complete the development and integration of the COS.
- Develop and maintain an executable J-UCAS architectural model.
- Provide available infrastructure to support technology identification and evaluation (e.g. simulation, labs, etc.).
- Maintain configuration control of Interface Control Documents (ICDs), executable models, and COS releases.

***** Each objective contains a number of tasks. Some are minimum tasks, the rest are additional tasks.**

Minimum + Additional = Maximum



Proposal Guidance

- **Executive Summary**
- **Technical approach to the 6 objectives, divided into 2 sections:**
 - Minimum tasks
 - Additional tasks
- **Management, Staffing, and Facilities**
- **Proposed Agreement with Attachments**
 - TDD (minimum tasks)
 - IMP (minimum tasks)
 - IMS (minimum tasks)
- **Cost Response (minimum tasks)**
- **Certification of no conflict of interest**
